Description

COACHE Dean's Reports provide comparative tables that allow school or college leadership to gain insights into their faculty. Reports are delivered as Excel tables with means and frequency data for all items in the core Job Satisfaction survey including the benchmarks. The tables include disaggregation by tenure status, rank, gender, and race. As with all COACHE reports, any subgroups with fewer than five respondents are masked to protect respondent confidentiality. Open-text responses, custom questions and pass-through variables are not included.
